On-Line Group for Finding Partners

There is now a way for DCBC members to more easily locate partners I have set up a private group for us at Facebook. Facebook calls it a *secret* group. By being private, it will be unlisted and only available to those approved by the group administrator (me). That way, joining this group will not result in spam or other inappropriate messages. Whatever you post will be seen only by other members of the group. All you need to do is post a message like:

I am looking for a partner for Thursday . I usually play in the B section

Somebody accepting your invitation simply responds to the message by clicking the button marked “comment” and typing something like

I am free on Thursday and can play with you. Playing in the B section is fine.

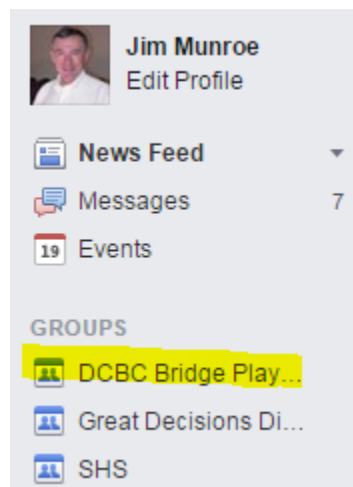
To become part of this group you must first join Facebook by going to

www.facebook.com

Under ‘Sign Up’, you will see several boxes that require information such as your name and email address as well as your birthday and gender.. You will also assign yourself a password. You do not need to give any more than this basic information although you will be encouraged to give more. Once you have an account either invite me to be a friend (there is a button at the top “Find Friends” or send an email to:

And I will add you to the group. Once you are added to the group, your Facebook page will have a *DCBC Bridge Players* link on the left under “Groups”. Here is what mine looks like
